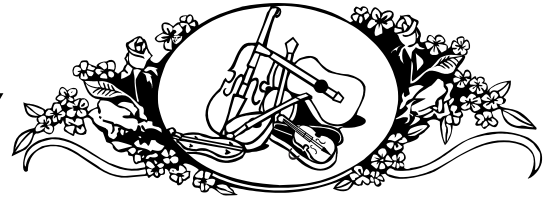

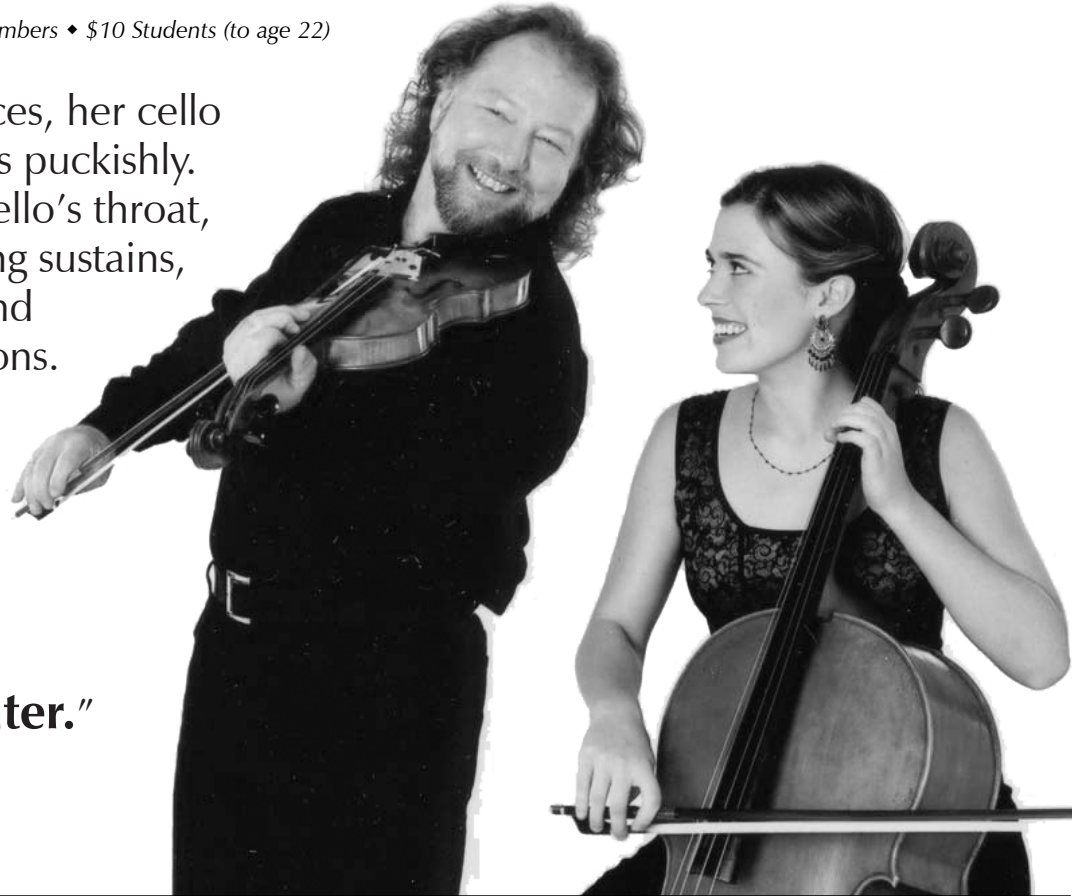
## Alasdair Fraser & Natalie Haas
