Harrisburg Academy Student Named National Merit Scholarship Finalist

WORMLEYSBURG, PA – **William C. '18** has been recognized as a Finalist in the 2018 National Merit® Scholarship Program (NMSP). NMSP honors individual students who show exceptional academic ability and potential for success in rigorous college studies.



The NMSP has now determined which of the 16,000 Semifinalists named in September 2017 have met all requirements to advance to Finalist standing in the competition. All Finalists will be considered for some 7,500 National Merit Scholarships that will be offered this spring.

Keo Oura Kounlavong-Sabath, the Academy's director of college counseling, said, "Harrisburg Academy supports its students throughout the college preparatory process. We are proud to have a challenging academic program that prepares our students for success in their collegiate pursuits and beyond."

In our last five graduating classes, more than 10 percent of all Harrisburg Academy seniors have been celebrated as Commended Scholars, with 6 percent advancing to achieve Semifinalist status. Of those Semifinalists, six students have finished the program as Finalists, with one earning the Merit Scholar title and a \$2,500 scholarship.

National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC), a not-for-profit organization that operates without government assistance, was established in 1955 specifically to conduct the annual National Merit Scholarship Program. Scholarships are underwritten by NMSC with its own funds and by approximately 440 business organizations and higher education institutions that share NMSC's goals of honoring the nation's scholastic champions and encouraging the pursuit of academic excellence.
