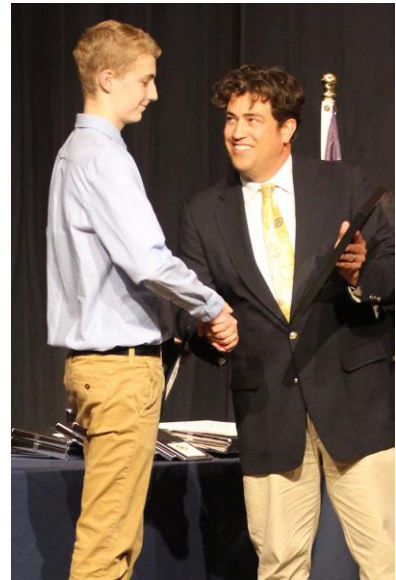

Harrisburg Academy Freshman Achieves Perfect Score on the National Latin Exam

WORMLEYSBURG, PA – Harrisburg Academy freshman, Liam D. '20, achieved a perfect score on the 2017 National Latin Exam. Only 813 students out of over 135,000 who participated in the United States, Taiwan, Canada, England, New Zealand, Australia, Hong Kong, Netherlands, China, Italy, Germany, Singapore, Belize, France, Spain, Zimbabwe, and the United Arab Emirates attained this distinction.

The National Latin Exam promotes the study of Latin and encourages each student to achieve personal success in his or her study of the Latin language and culture. Liam has been studying Latin for two years at the Academy and received the 2016 Middle School Latin Award for excellence in 8th grade.
