The new division-wide program, “Core & Explore,” will roll out beginning with the 2018-19 academic year.

Highlights of the Academy’s 2018-19 Early Childhood division tuition schedule include:

- \$15,000 for full-year (Aug. through July), full-day learning, including an Early Childhood focused summer camp and vacation coverage programming
- \$14,000 for academic-year-only (Aug. through June), full-day learning
- No additional fees for before-care and early drop-off beginning at 7 a.m.
- No additional fees for after-school care until 5:30 p.m.
- Additional scheduling options (with prices scaled down appropriately) for families that desire part-time Preschool enrollment, such as mornings-only, or three days-per-week. Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten remain full-day programs (8 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.)
- Special classes as part of the regular tuition, including music, gym, science lab, Spanish, and strings instruction

The Academy strives to remain competitive in an ever-changing economy and as such, has also addressed tuition in its elementary, middle, and high school grades. The Academy will freeze tuition at current rates for the upcoming 2018-19 academic year:

- Lower School: \$17,700 (Extended Day Program included until 5:30 p.m., free of charge)
- Middle School: \$19,300
- Upper School: \$20,400

Students in Lower, Middle, and Upper Schools are eligible to apply for need-based financial aid; merit scholarships for new students are also available beginning in 5th grade.
