



2017-18 and 2018-19 Academic Years

For students who are not U.S. citizen, do not hold a U.S. passport and are not permanent residents of the U.S. there is a \$4,000 international student registration fee for their first year at Harrisburg Academy. This fee offsets a range of services for international students and their families who live outside of the United States and are here on an F-1 Student Visa, including some ESL support services.

- Incoming international students will take an English placement test during Orientation.
- A second ESL exam is given later in the year to assess student progress in their English studies.
- ESL services are designed to provide the resources and support needed to strengthen their existing English Language skills.

For students returning to Harrisburg Academy for a second year, the registration fee of \$3,000 includes both the initial formal assessment and then the later exam to determine ongoing English proficiency. Students paying \$2,000 or \$1,000 registration fees are also eligible for decreasing levels of ESL services.

Registration fees, summary of services, and rates for additional ESL instruction is presented below.

The international student registration fee will also cover a week of orientation that focuses on ESL instruction, academic writing, school culture, academic integrity, and summer reading. There will also be activities to meet other students and explore Harrisburg. The orientation helps transition the international students to the first weeks of school at Harrisburg Academy.

Additional information:

- New International students are expected to arrive prior to August 20, 2018, to participate in orientation. Returning International students are to return by August 23, 2018.
- Hours of instruction and screenings include those that are provided during the back-to-school orientation.
- For students paying \$2,000 registration fee, they are eligible for ESL during the orientation but no further services are included.
- "Course selection fees" paid through regular invoicing can be used towards ESL services.
- For students who receive 50% or more of financial aid/merit aid, ESL services are not included in the financial aid/merit award and will be required as an add-on service at rates noted above.
