Academy Student Named Commended Scholar in 2019 National Merit Scholarship Program

WORMLEYSBURG, PA – Harrisburg Academy student **Alec W. '19** has been recognized as a Commended Scholar in the 2019 National Merit® Scholarship Program.

The National Merit Scholarship Program (NMSPP) honors individual students who show exceptional academic promise. About 34,000 students throughout the nation have been recognized as Commended Scholars. Although Alec will not continue in the 2019 competition for National Merit Scholarship awards, he has placed in the top 50,000 of more than 1.6 million students who entered the 2019 competition by taking the 2017 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®).

Since 2012, more than 12 percent of all Harrisburg Academy seniors have been celebrated as National Merit Commended Scholars, with five percent of those achieving Semifinalist. Of those Semifinalists, seven students finished the program as Finalists.

“I am pleased that we have a student recognized as a Commended student for the 2019 National Merit Scholarship Program,” said Keo Oura Kounlavong-Sabath, director of college counseling. “The selection for this recognition has grown more competitive since the redesign of the PSAT a few years ago, and we are pleased to see that our students are still able to be recognized for their academic ability on a national scale.”

National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC), a not-for-profit organization that operates without government assistance, was established in 1955 specifically to conduct the annual National Merit Scholarship Program. Scholarships are underwritten by NMSC with its own funds and by approximately 420 business organizations and higher education institutions that share NMSC’s goals of honoring the nation’s scholastic champions and encouraging the pursuit of academic excellence.
